Origins

- Rumoured DVR seeking very substantial expansion of its network
- Expansion remains DVR's ambition see website
- FELP NOT opposed to DVR's current operations but concerned about expansion impinging on other Park users, especially the many casual users



Labor's \$2 million pre-election pledge for:

- Cricket and Lacrosse pavilion \$1million
- Off-leash dog park \$0.5million
- Environmental revegetation/restoration, amenity etc – \$0.5million
- Off-leash dog park concept plan being revised
- Money for projects set to flow but around \$160,000 already lost to inflation
